Scholastic Activities

Evaluation is an indispensable part of education process and some form of assessment is necessary to determine the effectiveness of teaching learning process. One of the main purposes of evaluation at the school stage is to help the learners to improve their achievement in all areas. Scholastic as well as Co-scholastic. Evaluation system is devised to inculcate the habit of regular systematic and methodical work among the students.

For Classes LKG-II

Evaluation during 3 to 7 years of age is measured by teachers ongoing observation over the whole year and not on a single test. Child's progress is compare to his or her previous achievement and not with others. The evaluation is used to diagnose the learning difficulties and inadequacies of the learner. Comprehensive evaluation system is used. Assessment of the child's progress will be recorded and will be shown to the parents after three months through cumulative card.

1st Assessment– April to August '21

2nd Assessment-September to December '21

3rd Assessment-January-March'22

The cumulative card shows development of the child in different areas with remarks as always, usually some time and needs attention.

For Classes III-V

1. There will be four circles and grading system will be followed for the same
2. Each circle test will be of 25 marks for classes 3rd to 5th.

3. Subject enrichment activities, classwork and homework, notebooks, project and art integrated work will also be evaluated and will carry weightage of 25 marks
4. In circle test 2,3 & 4 some syllabus of the previous circles will also be included therefore a cumulative assessment will be done.

For Classes VI-VIII

1. The session is divided into two terms. The term will have one periodic test each.
2. Each term will have a written exam of 80 marks and 20 marks will be of internal assessment.

1. The session is divided into 3 periodic tests and 1 Annual examination at the end of the session.
2. Annual examination will be of 80 marks and 20 marks internal assessment which includes;
3. Pen and paper test
4. Multiple Assessments
5. Portfolio (class work plus peer self-assessment, achievement of the student in the subject)
6. Subject Enrichment
7. One Project in every subject. Student has to secure 33% marks in internal and annual examination combined together to be legible for promotion to next class. Cumulative syllabus will be assessed in 2nd and 3rd periodic and the entire syllabus will be assessed in 8. Annual examination at the end of the session.
