You are well aware that as per the latest National Education Policy 2020 & National Curriculum Framework 2022, the age range of 3 to 8 has been articulated as the Foundational Stage, in the new 5+3+3+4 system. Consequently, a new class has been added to Early Education Development Programme (EEDP), i.e. there will be three (3) classes instead of two (2) from this academic session i.e. from April 2024 before the child enters Class 1, as mentioned below:

In Dav Brij Vihar, in Nursery that is the starting of foundational stage .A child in the age group of 3 to 4 years,we have a curriculum that is multi-faceted, play- oriented, discovery -based and experiential, and which develops all aspects of the lerner's personality. All this will be done purely through play way method. We at DAVBrij Vihar spend more time helping children identify their natural competencies and gifts and cultivate them and not ranking them at this foundational stage. Child's Assessment in Nursery will be done through observation, anecdotes and samples of work done by the child, no test or exam oral or written will be taken. Assessment will be ongoing and continuous and will be done by interpreting the evidence from day-to-day experiences of the child.

CLASS LKG-II

Assessment during 4 to 8 years of age is measured by teachers' ongoing observation over the whole year and not on a single test. Child's progress is compared to his or her previous achievement and not with others. The evaluation is used to diagnose the learning difficulties and inadequacies of the learner. Comprehensive evaluation system is used at the primary stage. Assessment of the

child's progress will be recorded and will be shown to the parents after three months ,through a cumulative card.

1st Assessment– April to August '2024 2nd Assessment-September to December '2024 3rd Assessment-January-March 2025

The cumulative card shows development of the child in different areas with remarks egs: Always ,Usually ,Some time and Needs attention.
